Made in PEI: Rights, Responsibilities, Relationships & Resources (**The 4Rs**) is a collaboration of the: PEI Human Rights Commission, Department of Education & Early Childhood Development, English Language School Board, PEI Teacher's Federation and UPEI Faculty of Education.

**4Rs** goals include facilitating the delivery of meaningful human rights education in PEI classrooms.

**4Rs 3-Packs** include grade-specific, DEECD-approved learning activities designed to address human rights concepts *and* Specific Curriculum Outcomes (SCOs) in a cross-curricular manner. Through the learning activities, students will explore fundamental human rights concepts and develop the **4Cs** of 21<sup>st</sup> Century Skills: *Communication, Collaboration, Creativity and Critical-thinking*.
