4Rs goals include facilitating the delivery of meaningful human rights education in PEI classrooms.

4Rs 3-Packs include grade-specific, DEECD-approved learning activities designed to address human rights concepts *and* Specific Curriculum Outcomes (SCOs) in a cross-curricular manner. Through the learning activities, students will explore fundamental human rights concepts and develop the **4Cs** of 21st Century Skills: *Communication, Collaboration, Creativity and Critical-thinking*.
